

Privacy Policy (last revised on JULY 24, 2017)

The California Association of Social Rehabilitation Agencies (“CASRA”) is committed to protecting the privacy of individuals, companies and organizations that visit this website (“Site”) (“Visitors”) and organizations that are members of CASRA (“Member Organizations”). This Privacy Statement describes CASRA’s privacy practices with respect to use of the Site.

In addition to acceptance of and compliance with CASRA’s Terms of Use, each Member Organization’s (including any of its employees, officers, directors, agents, consultants or other representatives, all of whom will be collectively referred to herein as “Members”) or Visitor’s use of this Site is also conditioned on his/her/its acceptance of this Privacy Policy. The Site

The Site is managed by CASRA and its third party software and hosting services providers (for the remainder of this Privacy Policy, collectively, “CASRA”). As set forth in the Terms of Use, if you link to any third party websites via the Site, such third party sites are governed by their respective terms of use and privacy policies.

Information Collected

When expressing an interest in obtaining additional information about CASRA or becoming a Member Organization, CASRA requires Visitors and Member Organizations to provide contact information (name, organization name, address, phone number and email address, collectively, “Contact Information”) to enable CASRA to email information in reply.

As you navigate the Site, the CASRA may also collect information through the use of commonly-used information-gathering tools such as cookies and Web beacons (“Site Navigational Information”). Site Navigational Information includes standard information from a Web browser (such as browser type and browser language), an Internet Protocol (“IP”) address and the actions taken on the Site (such as the pages viewed and the links clicked).

CASRA may use cookies or Web beacons to make interactions with the Site easy and meaningful and to improve the Site and email communications. When a Visitor or Member visits the Site, CASRA’s servers may send a cookie to that individual’s computer that only recognizes that individual’s Web browser. All individuals remain anonymous to CASRA until someone chooses to submit Contact Information. When an individual visits the Site, CASRA collects that person’s IP address to track and aggregate non-personal information.

The CASRA may conduct online polls or surveys on the Site or via a third party online- and/or email-based survey tool and ask participants to provide information that is not personally-identifiable in the course thereof, i.e., city or state of residence, age or gender.

CASRA offers Visitors and Members that provide any Contact Information the ability to update or change such information at any time. To update Contact Information, please email casra@casra.org or call (925) 229-2300.

Children under the age of eighteen should not provide any personal information on this Site. CASRA complies with all applicable laws that provide additional privacy protections for children who use the Internet and, in the course of such compliance, CASRA will not retain any information provided by a Visitor or other individual whom we know to be under 18.

Use of Collected Information

CASRA uses Contact Information to circulate its newsletter, provide information to its Member Organizations and otherwise fulfill its obligations to its Member Organizations.

CASRA uses Site Navigational Information to operate and improve the Site. CASRA may also use Site Navigational Information alone or in combination with Contact Information to provide information about CASRA and its operations, respond to requests for information, or fulfill CASRA's legal and regulatory obligations.

As between CASRA and all other third parties, CASRA is the sole owner of Contact Information and does not sell, share or rent this Information to any third parties except as disclosed herein. CASRA may store Contact Information itself or arrange for storage in databases maintained by CASRA's software vendors or hosted services providers; CASRA retains all right, title and interest in and to such databases and the Contact Information contained therein; provided that nothing herein limits or eliminates a Member Organization's or a Visitor's ownership of any and all information that it submits to the Site.

Sharing of Collected Information

Service Providers

CASRA may share its Member Organizations' Contact Information with third party service providers and vendors so that these entities can provide or offer services to Member Organizations and ensure the quality of such Services. CASRA will post a current list of its Member Organizations on the Site, which list may include staff names and titles; provided that, on a Member Organization's request, CASRA will delete that Member Organization from this list.

CASRA does not share, sell, rent or trade any Contact Information or any information generated by or resident on the Site with third parties for promotional, marketing or advertising purposes. CASRA does not authorize the collection of Contact Information by third parties through advertising technologies deployed on the Site.

Compelled Disclosure

CASRA reserves the right to use or disclose information, including Contact Information, if required by law or if CASRA reasonably believes that use or disclosure is necessary to protect CASRA's rights and/or to comply with a judicial proceeding, court order, or legal process.

Aggregate and Anonymous Information

CASRA may share aggregate and/or anonymous information about Members or Visitors with third parties for marketing, research or similar purposes.

Social Media Features

The Site may use social media features such as the Facebook "like" button ("Social Media Features"), which may collect IP addresses and set cookies to enable its features to function properly. Social Media Features are either hosted by a third party or hosted directly on the Site. Any Visitor's or Member's interactions with these Features are governed by the privacy policy of the company providing the relevant Social Media Features.

Business Transfers

If CASRA is acquired by or merges with another entity or all or substantially all its assets or operations are transferred to another entity, CASRA may transfer its Contact Information to that new entity.

Security

CASRA and its third party software vendors and hosting services providers employ industry-standard administrative, technical, organizational and physical measures in compliance with applicable laws and regulations to protect the security of CASRA's Contact Information and to protect against unauthorized access thereto or the unauthorized use or disclosure thereof.

Do Not Track – California disclosure

Currently, various browsers – including Internet Explorer, Firefox, and Safari – offer a "do not track" or "DNT" option that relies on a technology known as a DNT header, which sends a signal to websites visited by the user about the user's browser DNT preference setting. CASRA does not currently commit to responding to browsers'

DNT signals with respect to the Site, in part because no common industry standard for DNT has been adopted by industry groups, technology companies or regulators, including no consistent standard of interpreting user intent. CASRA takes privacy and meaningful choice seriously and will make efforts to continue to monitor developments around DNT browser technology and the implementation of a standard.

Changes to this Privacy Policy

CASRA reserves the right to change this Privacy Policy at any time. CASRA will use all diligent efforts to provide notification of any material changes to this Privacy Policy through the Site at least 30 days prior to the implementation of such change.
